#### AAP News Part 1 - From Task Force to Subcommittee Cribs for Kids education and work is built on the foundation of the



American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) Recommendations for Reducing Infants Deaths in the Sleep Environment as researched, reviewed, and released by the AAP's SIDS Task Force. Within the AAP a task force is not meant to be permanent. As a show of its commitment to this expert team's work, the AAP has elevated the group to a subcommittee. The SIDS Task Force is now formally known as the Subcommittee on Sudden Unexpected Infant Death (SUID). The AAP's SUID Subcommittee is part of the Council on Injury, Violence, and Poison Prevention (COIVPP). You will now hear the task force referred to as

the subcommittee. This is exciting news for the vital work we all do prevent infant deaths that is driven by the subcommittee's expertise.
